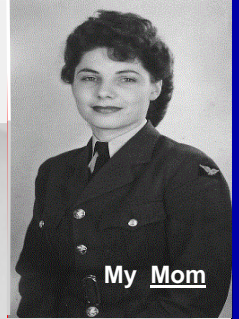

President Dwight Eisenhower (1953-1960) warned us about the "Military Industrial Complex". My Father was a military officer in US Air Force for over 20 years. We moved at least 5 times growing up. My father spent his career initially building the first early warning radar systems Barter Island, Alaska 1947-1950 to watch for Soviet bombers (pre-sarah palin); then communications systems in Europe for NATO 1955-1960; and later missile communication systems (pre-AEGIS) at the Pentagon 1960-1964.
